THE NEW GDPR (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION)

This became law across Europe on Friday May 25th. The Diocese of Paisley would like to reassure you that it takes your data very seriously, and will protect it in compliance with all aspects of the new regulation. We have established that there is legitimate interest as the legal basis for processing personal data, but will contact you directly if there is any need to gain your consent for any other specific purpose. There will be copies of our Privacy Notice at the back of your church or visit the parish website.

THE ANGELUS PRAYER GROUP
